#### Catalonia


- → Autonomous Community of Spain, recognized by the 1978 Spanish Constitution
- →Own Parliament and Government.
- → Two official languages: Catalan and Spanish.



## **Dependency Act**

- ✓ Approved by majority on November 30th 2006
- ✓ The law is universal and involves all Spanish citizens, but each of the regions has its own regulations to develop the law.
- ✓ Should become the fourth pillar of the Welfare State.

→ In theory, funded by three parties:


Catalan government (33%) Spanish government (33%) User (33%)

→ Three different degrees of dependence:

Degree I → moderate dependence Degree II → severe dependence Degree III → high dependence

→ 1,213,873 people recognized with dependency.

⇒348,309 people (29% of total dependent population) on waiting list.



### Good things about the Law


- For the first time in Spain, law establishes universal right to elderly care.
- Through this law, the number of people working in this sector increased significantly.
- At this moment **180,000** people work in this sector.
- Massive incorporation of women to labour market.



#### **Problems with the Law**

#### 1. Insufficient funding

- Since the last legislature, a budget cut was made by the Spanish government while needs increased.
- → Main challenge is paying a good salary to staff → Salaries are directly tied to government funding.





#### **Problems with the Law**

#### 2. Inefficient System

- ➡ Waiting list. The law has been in effect twelve years without a proper budget. Due to budget problems, at the moment there are 350,000 people on waiting list.
- Depending on the territory, the law is more developed, and so is the waiting list.
- People have died without receiving the benefits.






# 985 Assisted Living Residences (by typology)

# 985 Assisted Living Facilities (by number of places)







